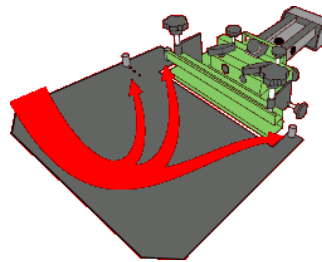

Exposure unit (#E2227) sold separately. If you have an exposing unit already, the "VRS Universal" will be your choice. That system will work with any Exposure unit.

1) Attach a set up to the pins. Position positive and tape to set up sheet.

2) Insert first sheet with positive onto Exposit pins.

3) Put your coated screen against the and exposit-it. Repeat for all screens.

4) Install the pallet jig onto your press.

5) Put your screen against the stops clamp. Repeat this all colors.

Note screen stops register pins.

Your screens are now register!

Note jig has screen stops matching Exposit.

Your ready to print minutes!

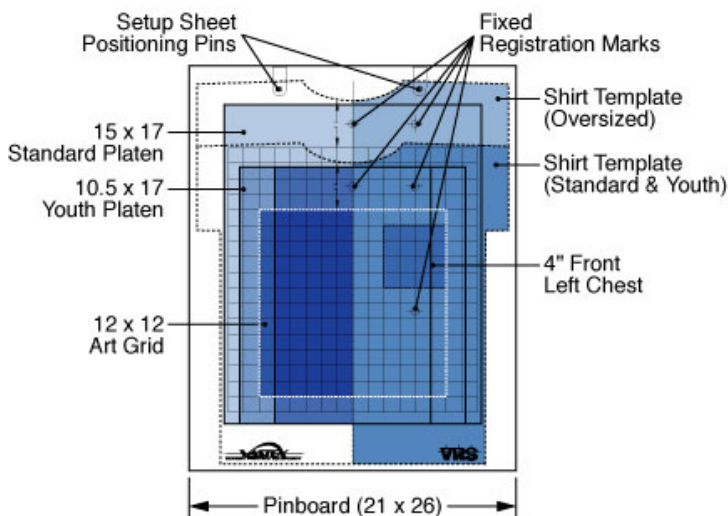


Figure 1: features of the new Universal Pinboard Grid. Color is for illustration purposes only. See photo below for actual appearance.

The newly unveiled **Universal Pinboard** is the key component in the **VASTEX VRS Universal Pin Registration System**, which now offers the speed and accuracy of a complete pin registration system to all screen printers, *regardless of what brand of manual press or exposing unit they use. Wood, aluminum, or retentionable screens can all be used, and no modifications are needed to existing screen inventory. This new pinboard features a newly designed Positioning Grid, which simulates a garment in position on your pallets. Now, right on the layout board, you are positioning artwork exactly where it will fall on the shirt, and on the screen! (see fig 1) This eliminates all guesswork, and makes screen setup, a breeze — for anyone.

The other crucial component is the **Screen Locator Pallet Jig**, which works on any rear-clamp, manual press. After the screen is exposed it is positioned on the Screen Locator Pallet Jig, which is fastened to the pallet. Then the rear clamps are tightened, and you're ready to print! Multicolor setup can now be done in minutes, even for the novice.

* Some limitations may apply, rear clamp width and pallet size must be reviewed.
